Dr. Eddie Cole releases new book The Campus Color Line



- **Dr. Eddie Cole** (M.S.Ed.'09, Ph.D.'13) has released a new book, <u>The Campus Color Line</u>, that examines the role college presidents played in segregation, racist housing policies, affirmative action and campus free speech debates in the years following WWII.
- Ibram X. Kendi, National Book Award—winning professor and author, calls it "A stunning and ambitious origins story. Embedded with breathtaking narratives recovered from meticulous research, this book vividly connects the actions of past college presidents to the racial issues that we, as a society, struggle with today."
